REVIEW OF REGULAR MEETING AGENDA:

Municipal Clerk Dugan reviewed regular meeting agenda.

Councilman McComas stated that there is a lack of recreation equipment at Lake Horicon park.

Councilman Seaman stated that he had sent an e-mail to the Joint Insurance Fund requesting a list of approved playground equipment.



To approve consent agenda. Roll call vote held. All votes affirmative with the exception of Councilman Seaman who abstained from the resolution regarding maintenance contract for the ESC as he serves as Fire Chief for the fire department which is housed in the complex. Mr. Seaman voted no to the resolution approving the Zeppelin Criterium bicycle race. Councilman Oglesby and Councilman McComas abstained from voting on the resolution regarding a raffle license for the First Aid Squad and the maintenance contract for the ESC as they are members of the First Aid Squad which is housed in the complex.

#### COMMITTEE/COUNCIL REPORTS:

Councilman Seaman reported that he attended the recent Board of Education meeting and added that “there are positive things in the air.”

Council President Davis reported that Councilman Oglesby will discuss a public safety issue concerning electronic devices.

Councilman Oglesby reported that there is pending legislation which prohibits emergency responders from using electronic devices to photograph accident scenes or emergency responses, which is not only inappropriate but will now be a crime. Mr. Oglesby added that Borough policy and First Aid Squad policy already prohibits the use of electronic devices to photograph or record accident scenes and emergency responses.

Councilman Lowe commended Public Works Supervisor David Winton for getting the “sprinkler system up and running” at the ball field.

#### MAYOR COMMENTS:

Mayor Robbins announced that a circus, sponsored by the Lakehurst Fire Department, is scheduled for Thursday, June 14<sup>th</sup> with shows held at 4:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.

Mayor Robbins also announced that the Zeppelin Criterium bicycle race is scheduled for Saturday, June 16<sup>th</sup>.

Mayor Robbins further announced that Lake Horicon will be open for the season on June 16<sup>th</sup>.

Mayor Robbins reported that the bat house has been installed at the rear of Lake Horicon near the boat ramp and the butterfly house has been installed near the monument area.

Mayor Robbins also announced that the Farmer’s Market will begin on Sunday, June 24<sup>th</sup> and continue on Sundays through September 3<sup>rd</sup> from 8:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.
