**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Lakehurst is the recorded owner of real property approximately 30 feet by 125 feet known as **Block 25**, **Lot 16.01** lying within the Borough of Lakehurst, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey (collectively the "Property"); **and** 

**WHEREAS**, Charles & Doris Torluccio purchased this property via a tax sale certificate on December 28, 1977 and said certificate of sale was recorded in the Ocean County Clerk's Office on April 2, 1984 in Book 2511 at Page 230, and said Estate has since paid all real estate taxes thereon; **and** 

**WHEREAS**, a title search reveals title is still vested in the Borough of Lakehurst and it appearing no Deed was delivered nor recorded in the Ocean County Clerk's Office to the owner(s) prior to Charles & Doris Torluccio purchasing this property via a tax sale, leaving the last recorded Deed owner of the property as the Borough of Lakehurst; **and** 

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Lakehurst Mayor and Council having determined the Property transfer should be memorialized via the delivery of a Quitclaim Deed to the Estate of Doris Torluccio, inasmuch as this delivery of a Deed should have occurred but through excusable oversight was not delivered; and

**WHEREAS**, inasmuch as this transfer is to correct an oversight in the failure to deliver a deed, should be made for a nominal consideration of one dollar (\$1.00); **and** 

**WHEREAS**, the Borough and the Purchaser both inadvertently failed to conform with the proper transferring of the Deed;

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Lakehurst, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

#### **16-1.2** Type of Connections

- f. When a request has been made to the Borough, a separate meter to monitor lawn-sprinkling systems will be installed to accurately record water gallonage used by the system.
  - (3) Cost of said meter shall be one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125).
