WHEREAS, the Borough of Lakehurst is the recorded owner of real property approximately 30 feet by 125 feet known as **Block 25, Lot 16.01** lying within the Borough of Lakehurst, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey (collectively the "Property"); **and**

WHEREAS, Charles & Doris Torluccio purchased this property via a tax sale certificate on December 28, 1977 and said certificate of sale was recorded in the Ocean County Clerk's Office on April 2, 1984 in Book 2511 at Page 230, and said Estate has since paid all real estate taxes thereon; **and**
