Mr. Lowe also reported the baseball field will be redesigned along with refacing the diamond and dugouts adding they are waiting for some numbers. Mr. Lowe further reported the basketball court will be resurface and painted.

Councilman Davis reported through the veteran's organization, 110 names will be added to the Memorial Walk at Lake Horicon on Veteran's Day.
