WHEREAS, mail-in ballots were used predominantly in the Primary Election in July, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the practice of predominantly using mail-in ballots for all registered voters caused concerns for voter fraud, voter disenfranchisement, postal delivery delays, significant increase in election costs, and reliance on a flawed Statewide voter/DMV computer registration data base and resulted in significant delays in the counting of ballots; **and**

WHEREAS, well before the COVID-19 pandemic, New Jersey law permitted voting by mail for any reason, or no reason at all, allowing any voter, even remotely concerned about in-person voting the option to request a mail-in ballot thus enhancing voter choice; **and**

WHEREAS, numerous voters have expressed a desire to wait until Election Day to cast their ballot electronically, in-person, for the candidate of their choice to fully assess the latest information available; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lakehurst is gravely concerned that the predominant use of mail-in ballots during the 2020 Primary Election was difficult at best and represents but a small fraction of the ballots to be cast when compared to the upcoming General Election; **and**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lakehurst feels strongly that voter "choice" should refer to "how" to vote, not just "who" to vote for in a given election cycle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lakehurst opposes the predominant use of mail-in balloting in the General Election in November, 2020 and in all future elections.
