Mayor Robbins further stated that from the governing body he has chosen Councilwoman Dugan and Councilwoman Hodges adding Municipal Clerk Capasso will forward the draft plan for reviewing. Mayor Robbins went on to say that once the review is completed, they will meet with the engineer to discuss recommendations.
